



Important Update: New \$12B Farmer Bridge Assistance Program - What You Need to Know



Dear Valued Farm Customer,

We want to make you aware of a newly announced federal assistance opportunity that may directly benefit your operation. In December 2025, the Farm Service Agency (FSA) introduced a \$12 billion Farmer Bridge Assistance (FBA) Program designed to provide short-term financial relief to U.S. producers facing elevated input costs, market volatility, and cash-flow challenges. This “bridge payment” program will support farmers until the next farm bill provisions take effect in 2026.

Key Program Highlights

- Purpose: Immediate financial support for producers dealing with rising fertilizer, fuel, and operating expenses, as well as market disruptions.
- Total Funding:
 - \$12 billion overall
 - \$11 billion allocated to row crops
 - \$1 billion reserved for specialty crops (details forthcoming)
- Administered By: USDA Farm Service Agency (FSA) under the Commodity Credit Corporation (CCC).
- Eligibility: Primarily row crop farmers — corn, soybeans, wheat, cotton, rice, and others. Specialty crop details will be released soon.
- No Application Required: Payments are calculated using your 2025 FSA acreage report already on file.

Critical Deadlines & Timing

- Acreage Reports: Must be accurate and submitted to FSA by December 19, 2025.
- Payment Rate Announcements: Expected by late December 2025.

- Payments Issued: Targeted for February 28, 2026.

✓ What You Need to Do Now

1. Confirm Your 2025 Acreage Report:
Make sure it is accurate and filed with FSA before the December 19 deadline. This is essential — payments will be based solely on that information.
2. Watch for Rate Announcements:
Crop-specific payment rates will be released later this month.
3. Prepare for February Payments:
Disbursements are scheduled to begin by the end of February 2026.
